Dr Seamus McAleer graduated from Trinity College, Dublin in 1981. He did his medical training in Altnagelvin Hospital for 3 years, with a year as Medical Registrar in the Royal Victoria Hospital. He trained in Clinical Oncology at Belvoir Park Hospital and the Royal Marsden Hospital, London. An MD thesis on novel drugs followed at the Queen's Haematology Department. In 1992 he was appointed Senior Lecturer in Clinical Oncology in Queen's, developing the Oncology Undergraduate module and Clinical Trials Unit. As Clinical Director of the Oncology service for 7 years, he led its modernisation and expansion. Academically, he focussed on assessment, and as Academic Lead for Assessment in the Medical School, he has led on assessment for the C25 curriculum. He became an examiner and later Medical Director for Education and Training at the Royal College of Radiologists. He has assessment roles for the GMC and Medical Schools Council Assessment Alliance (MSCAA).
